IC - table behind booth not secured

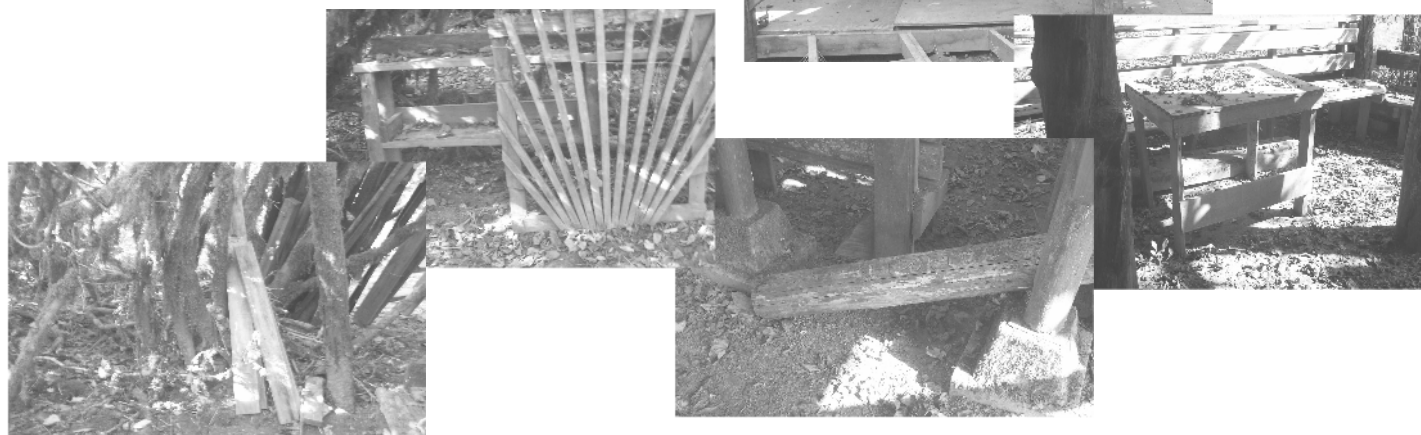
H&H - loose boards behind booth

Tapestry hanging job was passed from Jen-Lin to Dale (yea!!)

Need more open attitude toward new path idea

Security issues in meadow and Council camp were upsetting (Fair security got involved)
